- Raw part setup of individual components as they enter the line
- Creation of Bill of Materials for each line entering the market
- Keep current Standard Cost sheets for parts and SKUs up to date in all systems
- Aid in Monthly Forecasting/Reporting of sales (Months Coverage)
- Work with Supply Chain and Manufacturing to monitor inventory positions of all components to alert when changes need to be made

- Assist Production Control Manager in order processing of custom and production builds
- Create documentation for Manufacturing team to clearly define build specifications
- Aid the R&D team in qualification testing and confirmation of all new and upcoming parts
- Communicate with key vendors to align Mizuno's product offerings with their plans for addition, subtraction, and promotion
- Compile all information of part specifications for use on Website and Catalog
- Coordinate with other regions (Europe/Australia) to align all product directions
